ENFORCEMENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

- A. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH MICHIGAN'S SOIL EROSION AND SEDMENTATION CONTROL PART 91 OF PUBLIC ACT 451 OF 1994, AS AMENDED ("PART 91") IS A CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY RESULT IN ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS TAKEN BY THIS OFFICE: (1) A FINE UP TO \$2,500; (2) INSTALLATION OF SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROLS BY THE MUNICIPAL ENFORCING AGENCY WITH ALL COSTS RELATED TO THE ADMINISTRATION, LEGAL COSTS, PERMIT OR RENEWAL FEES AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CONTROLS TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE PERMIT HOLDER AND/OR LANDOWNER WHICH MAY BECOME A. LIEN ON THE PROPERTY IF NOT PAID; (3) A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER WILL BE FILED IN COURT TO RESTRAIN ANY AND ALL FURTHER CONSTRUCTION AT THE PROPERTY SITE, AND TO RECOVER DAMAGES TO THE NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE STATE; AND (4) AND ANY OTHER LEGAL ACTION NECESSARY TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WTITH MICHIGAN LAW.
- B. A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES PART 91 OR KNOWINGLY MAKES A FALSE STATEMENT IN AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMITOR IN A SOIL AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL PLAN MAY BE ORDERED TO PAY A FINE OF UP TO \$10,000 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION.
- C. A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES PART 91 AFTER 5 DAYS AFTER THE MAILED OF THE NOTICE OF VIOLATION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A PAYMENT OF A CIVIL FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$2,500.00 OR MORE THAN \$25,000.00 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION. MCL 324.9121(1); 9121(2); AND 9121(3).
- D. BY SUBMITTING THIS AFFADAVIT FOR A WAIVER FROM A SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION PERMIT, THE LANDOWNER HEREBY CONSENTS TO THE FOLLOWING: (1) THE AUTHORITY OF THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, OR THE MUNICIPAL ENFORCING AGENCY TO ENTER UPON THE PROPERTY AT ALL REASONABLE TIMES FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTING AND INVESTIGATING CONDITIONS OR PRACTICES THAT MAY BE IN VIOLATION OF PART 91; (2) INSTALLATION OF SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROLS BY MUNICIPAL ENFORCING AGENCY WITH ALL COSTS RELATED TO THE ADMINISTRATION, LEGAL COSTS, PERMIT OR RENEWAL FEES AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CONTROLS TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE PERMIT HOLDER AND/OR LANDOWNER WHICH MAY BECOME A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY.
